I hope everyone is enjoying this great fall weather. This is an update from the annual meeting that was held August 25th, 2013.



In efforts to save money and keep road dues from increasing, we are coordinating a road work day. Please mark your calendars for OCTOBER 27th 2013.

- **The current board of directors are:**

Jeff completed his term as president this year, and I have taken his place. I have lived on the road since I was a young child, and my family represents four generations here in our neighborhood. I look forward to meeting some of you that I do not know!

I would like to welcome several new families to our neighborhood. Please feel free to reach out to the board if you have questions or concerns. We are always looking for new participants.

- The annual road dues will remain \$ 250.00 for the upcoming 2014 year.
- Updates from the treasurer include: SPRA savings account balance is \$17,339.75 and SPRA CD balance is \$18,980.68. Current outstanding moneys owed = \$2,280.24.
- Scheduled maintenance this fall includes: paving the far end of Sabbady Point Road, improving the road shoulders to help manage water drainage, and trimming brush and trees in the path of the snow removal equipment.

We will meet at the beginning of Dad's Way at 8:30am and plan to work till 11:30am. All help is appreciated. If this task is not addressed, we risk losing the large snow removal equipment and may not have as good as plowing services from the town. Our road needs to be accessible for emergency service vehicles as well. This maintenance is long overdue. **If you have concerns about brush and/or tree trimming on your property along the road shoulder, please contact myself or a board member.**

The town is suggesting we trim 5-6 feet beyond the road edge where possible. Your input is important to us.

The town also has suggested residents mark their stone walls and fences with reflectors. This will help with visibility and will minimize potential damage to homeowners and/or the town's equipment.
